Cinaton 2101 Touchless Kitchen Faucet



The Cinaton 2101 is a completely touch free operation kitchen faucet that is incredibly easy to use. It features an innovative iSense touch free technology with 5 IR sensors that contribute for water saving and great personal hygiene. The unit has no handle, no need of touching and zero germs as a result. It is easy to operate with and has a full water temperature and flow control

The maximum water temperature settings are there to prevent scalding for children, elders and disabled people. The faucet is fully ADA compliant which means that is easily accessible by disabled people. It has a solid brass construction and a single hole mount. It features an integrate Digital Controller which contributes for the easy installation. The unit also includes a 120/240 AC adapter and 4 AA backup batteries.

The size of the faucet is 9 x 2.3 x 14.9 inches and it weighs approximately 7.8 pounds. The unit has a Satin Nickel color and a chrome finish. The maximum flow rate is 2.2 gallons per minute and 80 PSI maximum pressure. It requires batteries to operate and they are included.
